## **PARENT'S PLEDGE**

- I will encourage my child to play within the rules and respect officials and coaches' decisions.
- I will teach my child to respect the efforts of their teammates and opponents.
- I will follow all reasonable requests by the coach, manager and club officials.
- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability and cultural background.
- I will not criticize or ridicule my child's or any player's performance during or after the game.
- I will not arrive at the field intoxicated/under the influence of drugs or drink alcohol/take drugs at matches or training.
- I will gain an understanding of, respect and abide by the club's policies and philosophy.
- I will not enter the field of play or the changing room unless requested by a club official.
- I will not engage in social media, forums, emails, blogs or other electronic media to negatively comment on any aspect of the Club, NSFA or opposition clubs (includes teams, players, coaches, match officials, club officials, parents or spectators).
- I will not engage in any behaviour that brings the Club or the NSFA into disrepute.
- I understand player and parent contact details are not to be used for any purpose other than operating and managing the team as required and approved by the Club.

I agree to abide by this code of conduct and to be subject to the rules and policies of the Northern Suburbs Football Association (NSFA) and the Club.

If I breach the above code of conduct, I understand the Club may impose a penalty ranging from a written warning to immediate player de-registration.
